<u>Anti-Bullying</u> This theme of this year's Anti-Bullying Week was 'Make a Noise about Bullying' and Mrs Cassiano and Mrs Hamilton ensured that Elsley children did exactly that.

In class and during a workshop the children were taught about the effects bullying has on self-esteem. Each class explored an area of bullying which led to the pupils showcasing their learning in a special assembly dedicated to the topic.

We were thankful that a member of Brent's Inclusion Team came in to watch the assembly. As a school we have adopted the 'Anti Bullying Alliance's' definition for Bullying which is *the repetitive*, *intentional hurting of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an imbalance of power*. The children are becoming familiar with what this means.

Applications for Reception places starting September 2015 are now being accepted online by Brent School Admissions. If your child was born between 1st September 2011 and 31st August 2012, you must apply for a Reception place online. There is no automatic transfer from Nursery to Reception.
