Nursery - 30 hours free childcare available

Children who attend Elsley Nursery achieve higher at the end of Reception, than those who start the following year.

Children across the school got creative during this year's STEM week. STEM focuses on aspects of Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths and this year's theme was 'Structures'. Each year group looked at a different form of structure;

these ranged from castles and architecture to railways and cell structure.







Some year groups went on trips, such as Year 3, who went to sketch the White Horse Bridge. Other year groups had visitors who came to run workshops, such as Year 4, who had a talk from an architect and Year 5, who had a whole day workshop on Railways from education staff at HS2.

In their design technology lessons, year groups such as Year 6 made 3D models of cell structures while Year 5 constructed structures out of spaghetti and marshmallows.
