
FYI: If Lee was any cooler he'd be a cucumber.

Gummy and Dwayne are searching in Gummy's dad's shed for snowshoes.


- **Gummy** It's no good. All I can find are these old tennis rackets.

- **Gummy** Too right it is. My dad can take up knitting if he wants something to do.




Gummy and Dwayne fix the tennis rackets to the bottom of their boots with some string. Then Dwayne spots something else.

- **Gummy** Why? I thought we were going after the Abominable Snowman – not having a picnic.



- **Gummy** I get it! The tea trays aren't really tea trays at all they're sledges.



- Gummy Says you. I still can't see him.






Dwayne Neither can I, but that's lucky.

- **Dwayne** No, of course not but you do have more brain cells than teeth!






Speed Thrills

- **Gummy** Sorry. Er ... how are we going to steer the sledges?






- **Dwayne** We don't need to steer them. We just point them at the bottom of the hill and they'll do the rest.


Dwayne In fact, it's cooler than a loo seat at the North Pole.






- **Question** Did you ever play in the snow when you were a kid?

Never spit when you're facing a cold north wind – you could take your eye out!




Take care when throwing snowballs – they can hurt!




Mystery Mob books are available from most booksellers.
