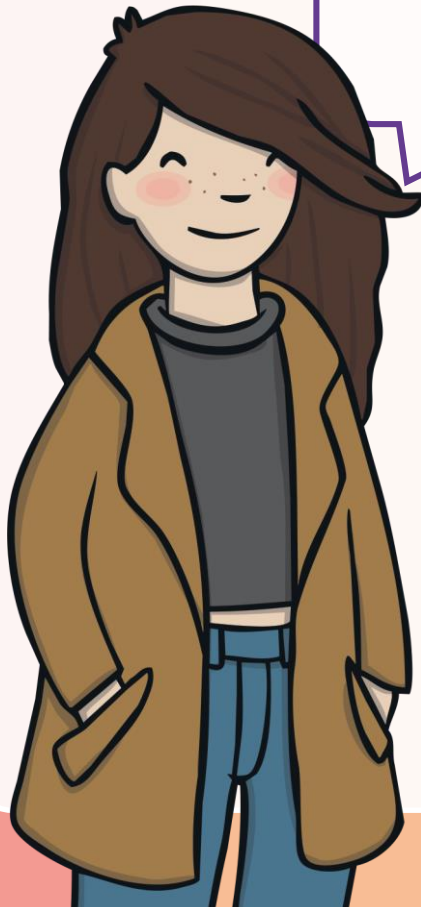

Let's read a poem about families and the love they share.



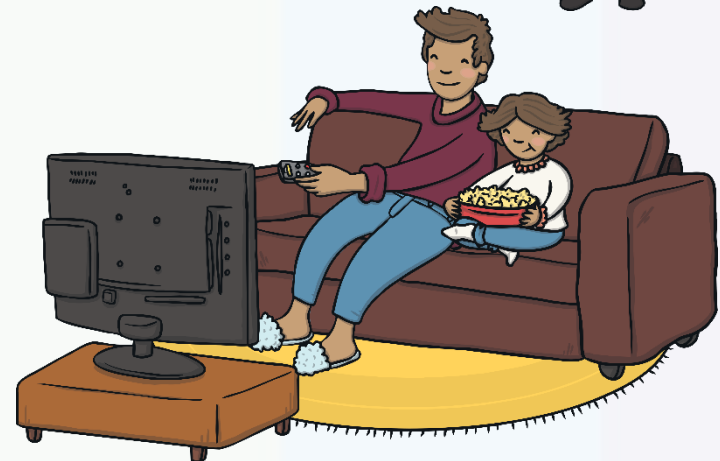
Different Families, Same Love

Different Families, Same Love



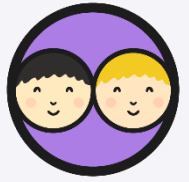
Amena has Grandma and Gramps,

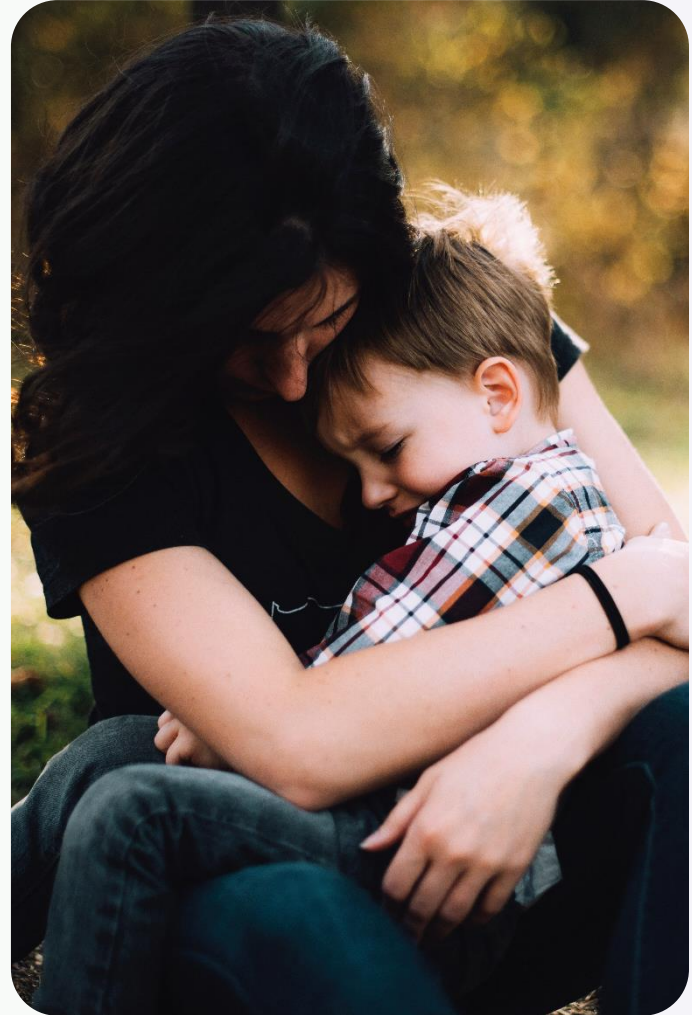

Our family care for us and support us. All families are special.

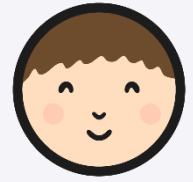

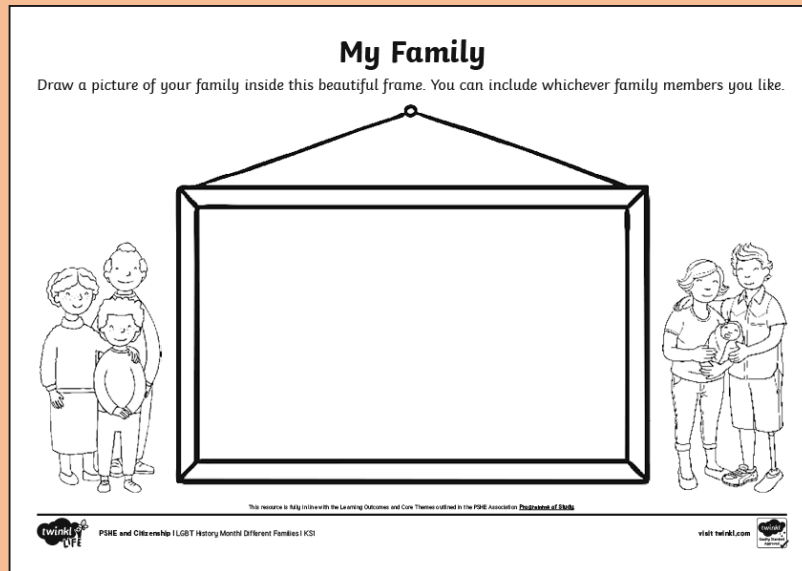

- Maybe you have two families and live in two different places?

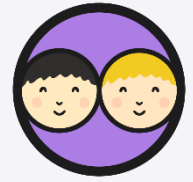


Today, you are going to draw your family members in a family portrait.

There is no right or wrong picture and all the pictures will be different because all our families are different.

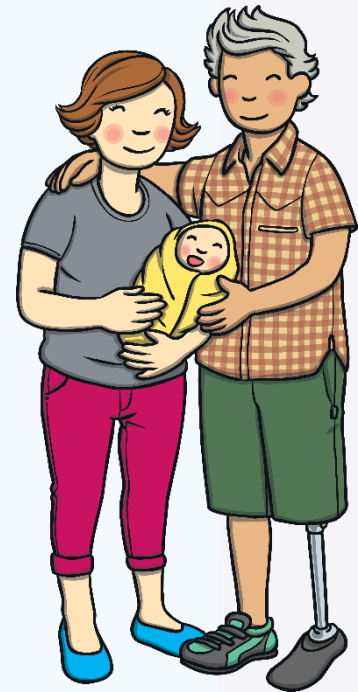
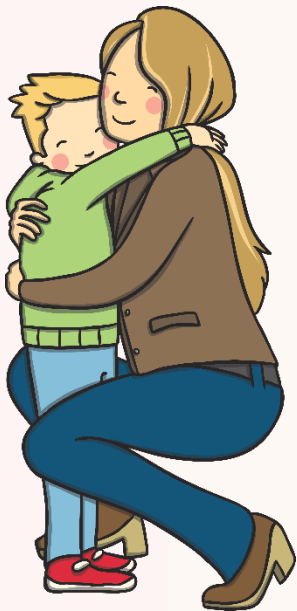

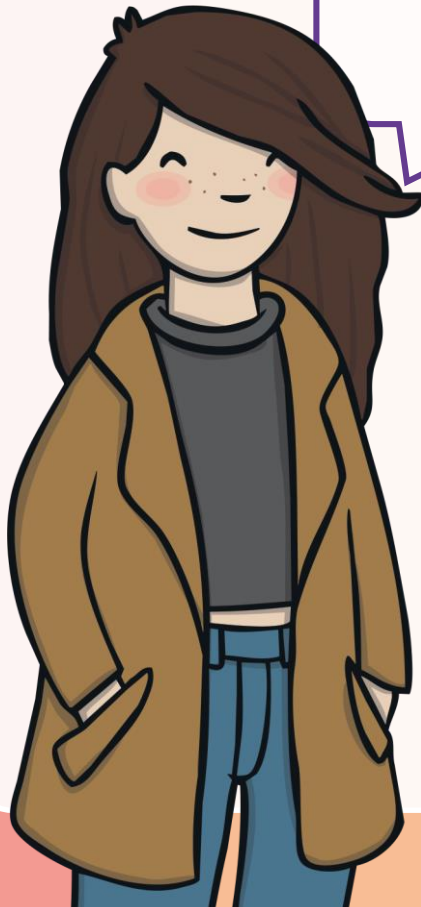
