Attendance / Punctuality Since last September, all year groups from Reception to Year 6 have the same start time of 8:55am with soft start commencing at 8:45am, except on Wednesday mornings. If your child is late please bring them to the office and sign them in the late book. **Persistent Absence** is attendance below 90%. This is equivalent to half-a-day missed every week or 4 whole weeks missed in year. Over a 5 year period, your child would miss half a year. Pupils with less than 90% attendance may be referred to the Education Welfare Service.

**Holidays during term time** are not permitted. In exceptional circumstances, leave may be permitted by submitting a form in advance. **The full attendance policy is on our website.**


